Seven years ago a mustard seed was planted in the jungle. And God made it grow out of a redeemed people eager to proclaim Jesus and His gospel. This past January The Church of the God of Perfection celebrated our 7th anniversary. Happy Anniversary Church!

Back in January of 2013 our church's inaugural worship service was in a rickety deserted building on top of the hill overlooking the village. I remember being nervous that someone would lean on a pole and the building would collapse. Our first year we worshiped outdoors. A year later a group of six Americans traveled to Kilbité. Each pitched in \$500 to build our first church building. We had dirt floors and no siding but we did have a roof over our heads for shade. And plenty of worshipers.

This January, God in His providence gave the church a huge gift in David Way, Jeff Becker, and Joe Vander Laan. These men, along with 20 laborers from the village, worked incredibly hard and got the building completed in time for worship. Concrete. Rafters. Roofing. We got 'er done. The new church building is wider, longer, with a higher ceiling. Much cooler! We really enjoy our new church home. Thanks be to God!

Every night for 2 weeks leading up to Anniversary Sunday we had Bible teaching, worship, and prayer. We ended that 2-week revival with a 6-hour worship service that Sunday. The ladies were up the prior 2 days preparing food for the entire village. During and following worship we literally ate the fattened calf. It was a joyful celebration. When I told the staff, we were all taking Monday off for some much-needed rest they cheered. We were one tired church after all that!

The Church of the God of Perfection is continually blessed by God. In seven years, we have grown to over 150 active members. Fellowship, prayer, evangelism, and discipleship are eagerly embraced. Since 2013 we've had over 130 conversions! The Church of the God of Perfection is a beacon pointing to Christ. We continually seek to please our Lord in humility and faith.

God also gave The Church of the God of Perfection a ministry to bless the entire village. A school! The School of the God of Perfection. This fall we will peak out with 94 students in grades K-6! The school is an effective gospel teaching ministry of the church.

That initial mustard seed has now become a sanctuary. Seven years ago I would have never imagined that God would do all this. For years I've been asking myself this question. How big is your God? And every time I answer it He keeps getting bigger. Now, I'm just trying to keep up.
