Dear Friends,

Haitians may think it impossible not to see their world collapsing in on them. The recent assassination of their president, hurricanes and earthquakes, gangs terrorizing people which interrupts food and fuel supplies are taking a huge toll.

Yet despite the worst of what a fallen world has to offer, when seen through eyes of faith, God's compassion and salvation continue to shine through and transcend this darkness.

The Holy Spirit has equipped God's Mercy to Haiti to stand in the gap on behalf of Kilbitè for the past 11 years. Every day in Haiti the gaps seem to widen. Yet by God's grace, we stand at the edge determined to bridge these gaps.

To better care for folks, the Lord has led God's Mercy to Haiti to two new ministries. Both ideally align with our ongoing missions of teaching and mercy. Both new ministries nourish. One... physical food for the hungry. The other... spiritual manna (His Word) for the mind and soul.

God's Mercy to Haiti has had to buy gas on the black market since September. Today it costs \$450 to \$500 to fill the tank of our Toyota 4Runner. The gas crisis has caused food prices to double. As a result, people in Kilbitè are extremely underfed and quite mal-nourished.

Your recent response to our plea for funds to help feed Kilbitè has been very encouraging. We have raised enough money so that The Church of the God of Perfection can feed one meal to the entire village 3 days a week for the next 4 months. Everyone in Kilbitè knows this loving provision comes in the name of Christ. We rejoice that prayers of thanksgiving and worship always accompany these meals to the village.

The village of Kilbitè and The Church of the God of Perfection wishes to thank you in advance and to tell everyone who has provided us food... THANK YOU AND GOD BLESS YOU!

Jesus taught us that anyone in need is indeed our neighbor. To my friends here in the US... please help me care for our neighbors in Kilbitè. Their needs are intensifying. Our commitment and determination flow from our faith in His promises to meet our needs. Please join us!

Since that first entry God has blessed me with opportunities to train 100's of pastors. As important as that was, God has now intensified His focus. God is using Pathways Ministry to equip God's Mercy to Haiti even further.
