However, even local travel can be dangerous. And there is significant risk traveling to and from the airport. Therefore, my personal travel to Haiti is limited. Travel decisions are made with my leadership in Haiti and GMH friends here in the US. We have faith there is nothing that can stop God from His purpose, for His people, and for His glory. We press on.*

*Ministries don't have to be big in number for God's Spirit to do great things. We try hard to stay connected with you. Prayer matters. Let's keep God's connections working through us and His Spirit. Thank you for praying and giving.*
