God has given us two and we have cheerfully returned to Him four, eight, even sixteen! We believe His promise... *"He who has been given, will be given more."* From tarp huts and mud floors we see His abundance in our church, school, and village. Our cup overflows!

As great as our spiritual abundance is, so is the depth our physical lack.

Because of the political unrest, the situation in Haiti has become extremely dire, even by Haitians standards. There are always needs, but now the needs have become greatly magnified. God's Mercy to Haiti supports the Haitian people in their desire to transform their society but we do not take sides on political issues.

Our school is in the Haitian jungle. Unlike most of the schools in the country, we were able to stay open during this crisis. However, we have been threatened by locals outside our village who have demanded that we suspend classes. And we have. Our children and teachers still gather, but wear street clothes instead of uniforms. Everyday we pray, read scripture, worship, and feed the children. We are praying that all of Haiti will resume classes this January.

In the midst of the hunger and oppression, God's Kingdom shines brightly in Kilbité. Our joy and faith in Christ transcend our suffering, and brings great glory to God.
